

WINTER 2016/17 Activities of the Friends of the Meaford Library




Thank you all!

Our 2016 fundraising season exceeded our expectations, with \$15,260 raised at the Net Shed and \$2,552 at the summer concert series. Likely it was a combination of all these things, but none of it would be possible without the hard work and support of our Friends' membership.

So we have a healthy bank balance, much of which is invested in GIC's, in anticipation of a new library building and room to expand resources and services. Then we will respond and provide the means for those "extras" we

know library staff would like to offer to patrons. Things are looking hopeful this might occur in the not so distant future!
