

SUMMER CONCERT SERIES

The Sunday evening concerts have now become a staple summer entertainment activity for Meaford citizens and visitors.

This year's series had eight of eleven planned performances take place. Three were cancelled because of adverse weather conditions. A fourth concert to replace the Rice Family concert was also cancelled. Of the four cancellations, only the original Rice Family date cancellation would have been necessary. The rest could have occurred had the pavilion curtains been available. To that end, our president, Leslie Ransom, has written a letter to town council outlining the inconvenience to all concerned that the lack of curtains has produced. The Farmer's Market has also written to the council regarding the same issues.

Below is the council's response.

Curtains for the pavilion will be in our 2025 budget which will be tabled in a few weeks.

Unfortunately the original curtains had reached their end of life and couldn't be reinstalled after renovations to the pavilion.

I attended several of the summer concerts which were all wonderful.
